Requirements for Each Applicant:

1. Current year graduate of Snyder, Hermleigh, & Ira High School.
2. Grade point average of at least 3.0 and minimum ACT scores of 18 or a SAT score of 800.
3. Completed application and evaluation forms.
4. Interview with scholarship committee if requested.
5. All information submitted to the counselor's office by May 17th. We will pick up by noon.
6. List any scholarships you may have received or are expecting to receive.

Various Amounts (Usually \$2000 to \$3000)

Term:

The scholarship award shall be made to the student. The scholarship should be used for university provided housing, board, fees, tuition, or books, and will be mailed directly to the student around August 1st.

Should the student decide not to go to college, we would like to receive the funds back to award to another student.

We will trust these award winners to use this money for school.

Instruction:

Selection for the scholarship recipient will include a screening of the applicants by an independent board, which will make the final selection.
