## **COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

The Friends of the Scurry County Library will give a scholarship that shall be used by a student during the year following graduation and who will be enrolling in an undergraduate program at a college, university, or vocational school.

All high school seniors who meet the following qualifications may apply:

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior at Snyder High School, Ira High School, or Hermleigh High School.
2. The applicant must have a Scurry County Library card and be in good standing. The student must have used this card for services besides just Internet and DVD checkout.
3. The applicant should be of good moral character and be in good standing in the community.
4. The applicant must be an average or above-average student scholastically (no grades lower than a C).
5. The student must have an application to a college or vocational school in process. The scholarship award will be sent to the college, university, or school.
6. Each applicant must submit a written application, references, and a high school transcript.
7. The student should submit two teacher recommendations, each no longer than ½ page. These should be attached to the application.

All applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee of the **Friends of the Scurry County Library**.
