RECRUITMENT GRANT REGULATIONS

Zeta Lambda Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma

- 1. A sum of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) shall be used by the student during the year following graduation.
- 2. The grant shall be given to encourage the student to enter the field of education.
- 3. The grant shall be given to a female senior student.
- 4. The Professional Affairs Committee of Zeta Lambda Chapter shall investigate all applicants and shall present the credentials of two of the applicants to the chapter.
- 5. The final selection shall be approved by the Zeta Lambda members on an impersonal basis.
- 6. The Recruitment Grant recipient shall be announced at her high school graduation exercise.
- 7. The money will be sent to the registrar of the college chosen by the recipient.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLICANTS

- 1. Each applicant shall be a senior in a Scurry County High School.
- 2. Through local school officials, each applicant must submit a written application and a high school transcript.
- 3. Each applicant must be an average or above-average student scholastically.
- 4. The applicant should have references written from two persons outside the teaching profession. One shall be a character witness.
- 5. The applicant should submit a written statement telling why they are entering the education field and what area they will train for.
- 6. The recipient should notify the President of Zeta Lambda Chapter if there is a change in plans before entering school or any time during the year.
